The Kamloops Canoe and Kayak Club, located at Shumway Lake, 15 minutes south of Kamloops, is a non-profit organization which provides quality programming and instruction of recreational and competitive paddling sports, including kayak and canoe, to individuals of all ages within a safe, fun and supportive environment.

We are currently seeking an enthusiastic, full time seasonal **Camps Leader** from middle of May – end of August 2020 to lead, manage and coordinate our spring and summer programs as well as to instruct campers on the paddling sports.

This is a full time summer job from **May 11th – August 30st 2020.**

Working hours: 40/week, 16 weeks total

Responsibilities Include:

- To provide feedback on the design and execution of daily programs and activities
- To assist with the training and managing of the summer camp instructors and safety supervisors
- To efficiently, clearly and enthusiastically provide paddling instruction to field trippers and day campers
- Meet and greet kids, teachers and parents, daily in a welcoming manner
- Prepare the club house for daily programs. This includes opening, cleaning, maintaining and closing club house
- Assist with managing, preparing and maintaining club equipment
- Prepare the safety motor boats daily for lake use
- Assist with organizing and coordinating on-water and dry land games
- To maintain a high level of safety both on the water and on dry land
- Create, foster and encourage a fun, team-oriented, fair play environment
- Exude respect and appreciation for the paddling sports
- Actively participate at all the water and dry land activities

Skills and Requirements:

- Able to easily develop engaging programs for day to day or week long activities
- Demonstrable experience working with and instructing children of all ages and varying skill levels
- Previous experience with a paddling sport: canoe, kayak or stand up paddle board
- Must be physically fit and able to lift 60 pounds
- Sound leadership, communication and organizational skills
- Ability to adapt to changes in daily plans quickly
- Ability to work flexible hours, including weekends in case needed
- Excellent character, integrity and flexibility
- The desire and ability to work in a team work atmosphere
- Exudes enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience and self-control
- Must have own reliable transportation to and from the lake or another paddling location in case needed
- Will be required to complete a criminal record check

Preferences will be given to those applicants who hold one or more of the following:

- Bronze Cross, Lifeguard, or Swift-Water rescue certification
- Red Cross Lifesaving Level 3 or equivalent
- National Coaching Certification (NCCP)
- Canoe Kids Instructor Certification
